
Mountain Birdwatch 2.0

Route 108: Mt. Martha, NH

Hike Duration/Difficulty: 2.5 hours.

Route/Trail Access: NH-115 to Cherry Mountain Trail, R on Cherry Mountain Road. Revised 9/2012

1	Facing E from pt 1.	Facing S from pt 1.	N 44.31723 W 71.49214 Elev(m) 965	Sawn-off fallen trees 15m to S. Fallen tree parallel to trail 15m into forest on W.
2	Facing N from pt 2.	Facing S from pt 2.	N 44.31952 W 71.49256 Elev(m) 989	Fallen 0.5m thick snag beside trail to E. Leaning birch 7m into woods on E side – straight trunk for 5m from ground, then leans sharply to N. 4-trunked paper birch beside trail to E. See photo 3328 for this.
3	Facing N from pt 3.	Facing S from pt 3.	N 44.32182 W 71.49252 Elev(m) 1016	Large sawn-off stump to E of trail. Upturned rootball to W. More open canopy to E.
4	Facing N from pt 4.	Facing S from pt 4.	N 44.32359 W 71.49439 Elev(m) 1016	5-m flat-topped boulder covered in moss to W of trail, 10m in. Point in the middle of an S-curve along trail.
5	Facing N from pt 5.	Facing S from pt 5.	N 44.32565 W 71.49595 Elev(m) 1034	1m boulder and 2.5m rootball beside trail to W. Sawn-off 3m stump 5m S on E side of trail.
6	Facing N from pt 6.	Facing E from pt 6.	N 44.32782 W 71.49712 Elev(m) 1025	4 standing snags & ~4 more fallen beside trail to E. 0.75m DBH* yellow birch to W of trail forks 3m above ground into 2 – resembles a Y.

*dbh = diameter at breast height

Please survey this route in order, beginning with point 1.
