

Mountain Birdwatch 2.0



Route 112: Crescent, NH

Hike Duration/Difficulty: 2 hours.

Route/Trail Access: Access from Randolph Hill Road. Take Crescent Mountain trail (follow signs for South viewpoint) or Carlton Notch Trail to Crescent Mountain Trail (gentler slope). Carlton Notch trail is 1.6 miles to Point 3.

1	 Facing E from pt 1.	 Facing W from pt 1.	N 44.39731 W 71.31329 Elev(m) 910	2m to W, 2 snags cross trail (no longer across trail as of 2011). Rootball & ledge 7m to W on N side of trail. 0.75m DBH yellow birch snag 15m W on S side of trail.
2	 Facing E from pt 2.	 Facing W from pt 2.	N 44.39783 W 71.31026 Elev(m) 863	To E, trail descends sharply under 2 fallen snags, cut on S side. 15M to E, trail passes rock ledge on N side. Point is 50m W of intersection with Underhill path.
3	 Facing E, 20m E of pt 3.	 Facing W, 3m W of pt 4.	N 44.39842 W 71.30724 Elev(m) 860	Point is 70m W of Carlton Notch/Crescent Ridge jct. Trail crosses into depression with 1.5m boulders to the W 3m away. 2M tall stump 10m beyond to the W. 6 foot high boulder with vertical split to the E 10 m away. 30m W of Point is a 20cm dbh spruce leaning across trail.
4	 Facing E from pt 4.	 Facing W from pt 4.	N 44.39875 W 71.30408 Elev(m) 851	Point is 50m W of intersection with Underhill Path. At point, trail slopes sharply down toward W. 3 standing snags 3, 9, 12m to W. Small rocks immediately east in trail.
5	 Facing E from pt 5.	 Facing W from pt 5.	N 44.40023 W 71.30150 Elev(m) 876	Trail enters lower, more open area with fallen trees and branches to W. 3 standing snags 10m E along trail. Flat rock 10cm high spans width of trail at point.
6	 Facing E from pt 6.	 Facing W from pt 6.	N 44.40200 W 71.29922 Elev(m) 916	Trail crosses dry creekbed/ water run off area with rocks. 10M to W, it enters a flat, moist, open area distinct from surrounding forest. Broken birch forms triangle over trail 10m W of (before) point.

Please survey this route in order, beginning with point 1.
