
## Route 3: Stark Mountain South, VT

## Hike Duration/Difficulty: 1 hour

**Route/Trail Access:** Jerusalem Trail and Long Trail S. Go to Jerusalem Store on Route 17 in Starksboro. Turn S on Jerusalem Road. At ~1 mi. turn left on Jim Dwire Rd and go about 1/2 mile to trailhead. 2.5 mi. to LT, moderate hike.

1	Facing N from pt 1.	Facing W from point 1.	N 44.18139 W 72.93685 Elev(m) 881	In transition zone. Heading up trail, pass ~ 7 birches in line on L. Point before trail bends R, then wiggles after long, straight, level stretch of birches (~ 30 m.)
2	Facing E from point 2.	Facing S from point 2.	N 44.18065 W 72.93392 Elev(m) 939	Large clearing to south. Point w/ 2 birch trees, 1 to L has blue trail marker on approach. Not the only clearing, but this one is quite deep away from trail, ~20 m.
3	Facing N from point 3.	Facing E from point 3.	N 44.17975 W 72.93108 Elev(m) 1028	50 m downhill of intersection w/LT. Point @ fir tree w/ blue blaze on back (uphill side?). Fir snag 5 m uphill from point, facing point. 1m high stump to L of trail facing East.
4	Facing N from point 4.	Facing E from point 4.	N 44.17752 W 72.93166 Elev(m) 1066	15-20 m S of wide open area on trail. Low mountain ash to E. Point just S of 2 m log parallel to trail, 2nd log diagonal to trail.
5	Facing N from point 5.	Facing E from point 5.	N 44.17540 W 72.9302 Elev(m) 1061	Clearing sloping downhill to E. Point @ rock in trail, spans width of trail 1 m long. Messy fallen tree to E 5 m before point. Fallen tree to R of path.
6	Facing N from point 6.	Facing S from point 6.	N 44.17315 W 72.92982 Elev(m) 1046	Immediately S of "archway" over trail. Just S of point, large (>1 m high, 2 m long) very mossy rock to R of trail. Point @ dead tree w/ cut side facing trail. Point at trail widening.

\*Please survey this route in order, beginning with point 1.\*
