

Mountain Birdwatch 2.0

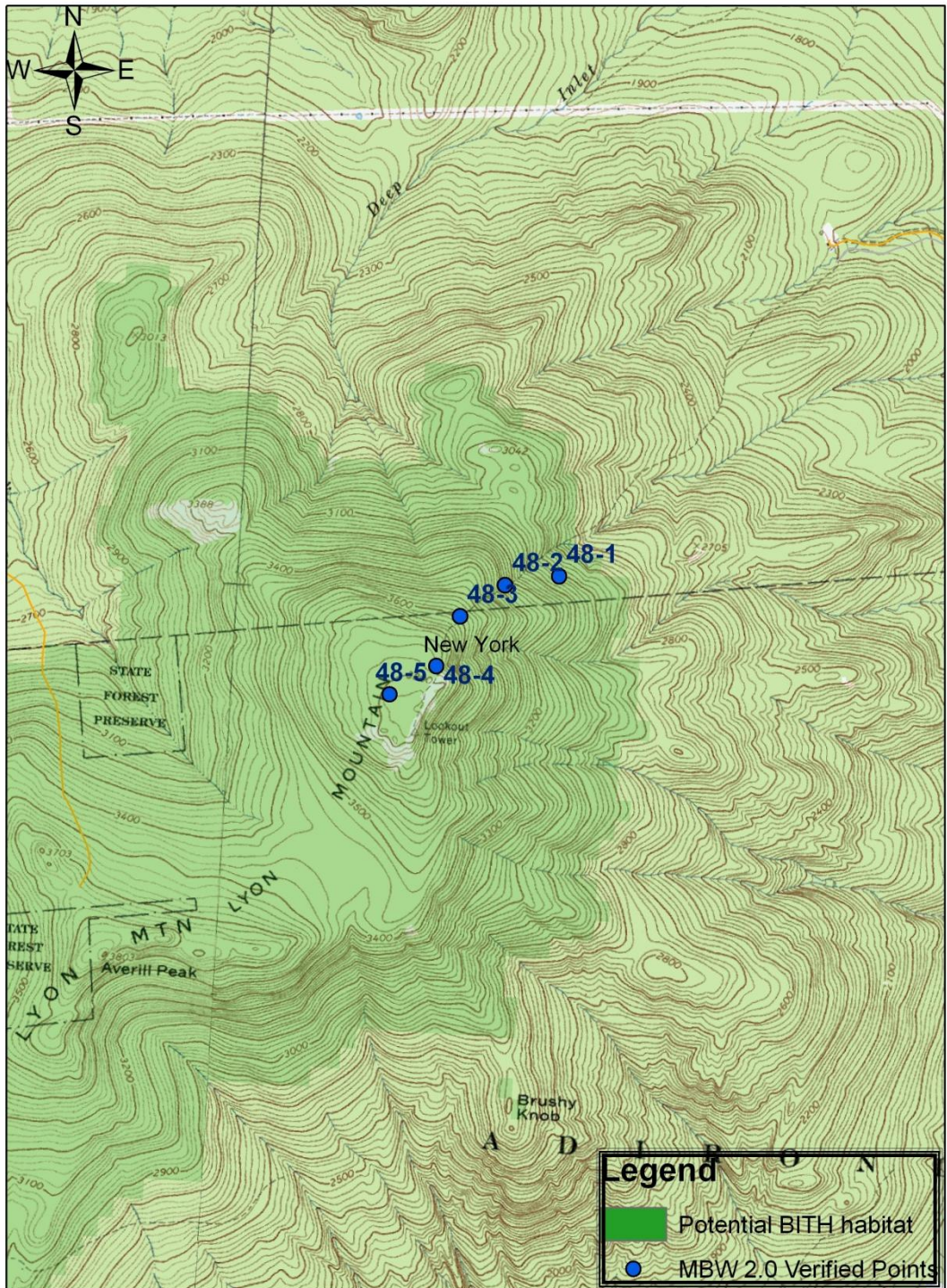
Route 48: Lyon Mt., NY

Hike Duration/Difficulty: 2.5 hours.











Route/Trail Access: Right turn about 1.5 miles South on Chazey Lake Rd from 143 on Seasonal Access Road. About 3 miles from trailhead. Trail marked with Orange DEC circles.

1	 Facing E from pt 1.	 Facing W from pt 1.	N 44.70954 W 73.85609 Elev(m) 939	Point is at the W end and 1m root mass of a downed paper birch that runs E/W along trail, raised off the ground about 3m at its bow. 10m W of an orange trail marker placed on a twin paper birch on S side of trail.
2	 Facing E from pt 2.	 Facing W from pt 2.	N 44.70907 W 73.85921 Elev(m) 1000	Trail turns sharply W, joining a 10m wide rocky washout, about 5m E and downhill of the point. Paper birch with 0.5m dbh* on S side of trail marks the spot.
3	 Facing N from pt 3.	 Facing E from pt 3.	N 44.70773 W 73.86176 Elev(m) 1102	2m wide + 1m high rock spanning the trail. About 3.5m tall boulders to the E of trail w/ vertical striations. At the N end of a narrow "S" curve. 10m S, trail narrows w/ boulders rising on both sides, predominantly larger boulders. Orange trail marker on trailside paper birch.
4	 Facing N from pt 4.	 Facing S from pt 4.	N 44.70558 W 73.86272 Elev(m) 1143	Trail levels out a bit. Some sand washout and small gravel begins on trail. 5m dead spruce 10m N before point. At point, stunted 3.5m tall balsam fir and continues on side branch, leans to the East. Trail straightens after sand wash.
5	 Facing N from pt 5.	 Facing S from pt 5.	N 44.70427 W 73.86541 Elev(m) 1163	10m S of rock cairn on old jeep road (?). 25m S there is an open, circular clearing. Rock cairn to the S marks the junction of hiking trail to the E and the jeep road which runs N/S.

*dbh = diameter at breast height. Please survey this route in order, beginning with point 1.
