Records of Vermont Birds

WINTER SEASON 1974-75

The Winter Season was a fairly normal winter for most of the state with average snowfall throughout, with the exception of the Lake Champlain area which was reported as having an "open winter". Most waterways remained open at least through December. There were reports of a good to excellent food crop statewide, which accounted for the poor showing of northern species in the southern half of the state.

Most birds were on the increase this year, most likely due to the growing number of birders reporting what they see. Northern species were plentiful in the northern part of the state with a "banner year" for PINE GROSBEAKS with 202 being reported on the Craftsbury CC and 464 on the Island Pond CC. Southern species continued to move north into the state in ever increasing numbers, while many migrants remained to winter over. Some of the more interesting hold overs were a BROWN THRASHER in Jamaica, WOODTHRUSH in Weathersfield, CHIPPING SPARROWS in Saxtons River and WINTER WRENS which were reported throughout the state.

Many interesting waterfowl were reported including the RED-NECKED GREBE, AM. WIDGEON, the BARROW'S GOLDENEYE on the Island Pond CC. It was also a good year for CANVASBACKS with 4000+ being reported by Fish and Wildlife planes over the Champlain Islands. Loons seem to be on the increase in the northern parts of the state (It will be interesting to see if we get many nesting records from this area). A LESSER BLACK-BACKED GULL on January 21 in Burlington must go down as one of the highlights of the season.

Hawk numbers increased over last year with particular rises in GOSHAWKS and SHARP-SHINNED. COOPERS were not reported showing a definite downswing over last year, although they are not that common here in the winter (probably last year was an exception). BALD EAGLE reports were on the rise and the <u>GYRFALCON</u>, OS-PREY, and MARSH HAWK reports were a pleasant addition. Owls were observed in ever increasing numbers with an interesting SHORT-EARED OWL roost of 4-15 birds found in Ferrisburg and checked fairly regularly throughout the period. The BARN OWL in Ferrisburg was also a good find.

An even more interesting roost was reported on Caspian Lake in Greensboro. This was a roost of RAVENS which grew from an unusual 15 birds on December 8 to an incredible 100+ peak on the 17th. Has anyone heard of other large roosts of RAVENS?

To top off a pretty decent season I would have to say that by far the most unusual sighting was the CAPE MAY WARBLER reported on the Ferrisburg CC. The unfortunate part was that it was seen in Essex, New York. Needless to say, it deserves noting. Better luck next year.
