FIRST STATE RECORDS

BLACK-TAILED GULL (<u>Larus crassirostris</u>) – one adult completing molt into non-breeding plumage, 18 October 2005, Charlotte Town Beach, Lake Champlain, Charlotte, Chittenden Cty. Julie Hart, Theodore G. Murin, Matthew Medler, David Austin and m.ob. thru the end of October. Photographs and photo CD's.

THAYER'S GULL (<u>Larus thayeri</u>) – one juvenile, 10 December 2005, Burlington Intervale compost works, Burlington, Chittenden Cty., T.G. Murin, Bryan Pfeiffer. Excellent photographs by Heather Forcier and Bryan Pfeiffer plus detailed and thoughtful write-ups allowed the committee to accept the identification.

RUSTY BLACKBIRD (<u>Euphagus carolinus</u>) – one nesting, 20 April 2006, Shrewsbury, Rutland Cty., Needs a better description of the bird.
