## FIRST STATE RECORD

LARK SPARROW (<u>Chondestes grammacus</u>) – one, 5 September 2012, Bragg Hill Rd., Norwich, Windsor Cty., Spencer Hardy, Doug Hardy, Cindy Crawford et al. First fully documented State Record. Three previous reports had been accepted as hypothetical. Photograph.

#### NOTABLE STATE RECORDS, SECOND THRU TENTH

AMERICAN WHITE PELICAN (<u>Pelecanus erythrorhynchos</u>) – one, 17 November 2011, Kent Pond, Killington, Rutland Cty., Roy W. Pilcher. Eighth State Record. Photographs.

BARNACLE GOOSE (Branta leucopsis) – one, 5 March 2012, Stebbins Rd., Vernon, Windham Cty., David Johnston, Don Clark, JoAnne Russo et al. Second State Record. Photograph. Although doubts persist about origin, the regional consensus is now to consider individuals of this species wild if they are seen with other wild geese in migration season.

SWAINSON'S HAWK (<u>Buteo swainsoni</u>) – one, 25 October 2011, Putney Mtn. Hawkwatch site, Putney, Windham Cty., Don Clark, John Anderson, Marshall Wheelock et al. Third State Record. Sketch.

WILLET (<u>Catoptrophorus semipalmatus inornatus</u>) – one of western subspecies, 30 August thru 8 September 2012, Shelburne Bay, Shelburne, Chittenden Cty., Allan Strong, Larry Haugh et al. Thirteenth State Record for Willet. First State Record accepted for Western Subspecies. Photographs.

WILLET (<u>C. semipalmatus inornatus</u>) – one of western subspecies, 29 August 2012, Delta Park, Colchester, Chittenden Cty., Jim Mead, Dwight Cargill, Jim Osborn. Thirteenth State Record for Willet. Although not described to subspecies in the RSD, the photos show the bird to be both an immature and C. s. inornatus. As such, this is probably the same bird as described above and we have treated this as the same individual.

ACADIAN FLYCATCHER (<u>Empidonax virescens</u>) – one, 26-28 May 2012, Old Otis Rd., Danby, Rutland Cty., Nancy A. Brown. Sixth State Record. Photographs and tape recording.

ACADIAN FLYCATCHER (<u>E. virescens</u>) – one, 26,28,31 May 2012, Crosshaven Farm, Moretown, Washington Cty., Chip Darmstadt, Scott Sainsbury, David Rankin, m.obs. Seventh State Record. Tape Recording.

# **REPORTS NOT ACCEPTED**

MAGNIFICENT FRIGATEBIRD (Fregata magnificens) – one, 15 July 2012, Route 30, Manchester, Bennington Cty., Brief sighting; insufficient details.

BALD EAGLE (Haliaeetus leucocephalus) – one, 2 April 2011, Lake Paran Rd. Bennington Cty., This was a rare nesting report; evidence insufficient to confirm nesting.

SWALLOW-TAILED KITE (<u>Elanoides forficatus</u>) – one, 7 September 2012, West Rd., Putney, Windham Cty. Photographs do not show a black and white bird.

RED-NECKED PHALAROPE (<u>Phalaropus lobatus</u>) – one, 10 August 2012, Dead Creek WMA, Brilyea Access, Addison, Addison Cty. Does not rule out other shorebird species.

BLACK TERN (<u>Chlidonias niger</u>) – thirteen, 28 May 2012, Charcoal Creek, Swanton, Franklin Cty. This was a Rare Nesting Report and contains no real evidence of nesting.

RED-HEADED WOODPECKER (<u>Melanerpes erythrocephalus</u>) – one, 4 March 2012, Putney, Windham Cty. Not enough detail.

RED-HEADED WOODPECKER (<u>M. erythrocephalus</u>) – one, 30 April 2012, Ralph Myhre Golf Course, Middlebury, Addison Cty. Not enough detail.

SWAMP SPARROW (<u>Melospiza georgiana</u>) – one, 8 February 2012, Pomainville WMA, Pittsford, Rutland Cty. Did not get a good enough look at the bird.

SUMMER TANAGER (<u>Piranga rubra</u>) – one male, 10 June 2012, Wake Robin, Shelburne, Chittenden Cty. Insufficient description.

SUMMER TANAGER (<u>P. rubra</u>) – one singing male, 5 July 2012, Wake Robin, Shelburne, Chittenden Cty. Vocalization only. Insufficient description.
