Two reports plus a video. The Committee considered Rock Ptarmigan as well, but decided the weight of evidence as well as the likelihood of appearance indicated Willow.

LARK BUNTING (<u>Calamospiza melanocorys</u>) - one, adult male nonbreeding. 1 October 2013, Royalton, Windsor Cty., Photographs were not good enough to positively identify to species.
