
Mountain Birdwatch 2.0

Route 7: East Mt., VT

Hike Duration/Difficulty: Will vary depending on if 2nd gate partway up Radar Rd is locked; if not, drive to barricade near old barracks (shown on map as clearing E of pt 1). Can camp on mtn. All points located along road. **Route/Trail Access:** Take Rt. 114 to Mountain Rd to Radar Rd (closed but unlocked gate) in East Haven, VT.

1	Facing N from Point 1	Facing S from Point 1	N 44.65363 W 71.77048 Elev(m) 901	Point is ~20 m below power line to N which crosses road. Crack runs across pavement at point. As of 2013, small branches of dead tree (3 cm dbh) point into road 2m off ground.
2	Facing N from Point 2	Facing S from Point 2	N 44.65583 W 71.77033 Elev(m) 930	Point is 50 M south of grassy pull off on east side of road. At point, guard rail visible to west, road bends to NE. Small (.5m wide) grass/dirt area in road at point.
3	Facing N from Point 3	Facing W from Point 3	N 44.65797 W 71.76929 Elev(m) 945	Power lines cross road 100m N of point. At point can see through trees to more open area to W. Guard rail exposed (visible) 5 m N of point on W side of road and at point on E side. Road headed at 40 degree bearing.
4		No second picture for point 4.	N 44.66029 W 71.76903 Elev(m) 966	Point is 60 m N of pull off on W side of road,10 m N of powerline crossing road. Road heads north. Straight crack goes all the way across road 8m N of point. As of 2013, downed cable on E side of point.
5		No second picture for point 5.	N 44.66241 W 71.7692 Elev(m) 1016	Point is 40 m N of pull off to E. Just off road (look carefully), telephone pole just to SE at 10 m. Another pole to NE (50 m) ahead on road. Coming from S, pass 30m of shorter fir to W. Point is 5 m into taller fir again.
6	Facing N from Point 6	Facing E from Point 6	N 44.66457 W 71.77 Elev(m) 1047	On road at height of mountain 30 m before radar building. Junk to NNE on road turnaround spot at point.

Please survey this route in order, beginning with point 1.
