
Mountain Birdwatch 2.0

Route 77: Speck Pond, ME

Hike Duration/Difficulty: 3 hours.

Route/Trail Access: Highway 26, Grafton Notch trailhead/parking lot. 3.5 miles on Appalachian Trail south toward Old Speck Mountain, @ turn off for summit stay on AT 1.1 miles more toward Old Speck Pond. Points begin on exposed rocky slope before pond. Revised 9/2012
