

5	Facing N from pt 5.	Facing S from pt 5.	N 44.02981 W 71.81062 Elev(m) 1208	Triangle-shaped rock sticking up in trail. Trail descends in tiers to N. Canopy opens up to S. Tag is on snag to E of trail.
6	Facing E from pt 6.	Facing W from pt 6.	N 44.02767 W 71.81178 Elev(m) 1233	Trail intersection w/sign is about 5 m to W. Somewhat open canopy. Very dense young fir trees. Tag is on young fir to S of trail in somewhat open area.
