The early fall of 1998 saw a return to the rainy weather that plagued birds and birders alike during the early summer. Precipitation during August and September was above average (2.74" and 2.34" respectively). Both months were warmer than normal with sunshine on more than half the days. Early August migration saw the departure of an out-of-season **Glossy Ibis**, and the arrival of **Little** and **Bonaparte's** gulls in Grand Isle. An estimated 80,000 Bonaparte's were counted on thirty-one boat trips throughout the fall. Shorebird migration continued on schedule and a surprising number of **Great Egret** began appearing all over the state. Three **Fulvous Whistling Duck** (the first of several species of unknown origin) made an appearance on 8 August at Herrick's Cove in Rockingham. By the end of the month **Red-necked Phalarope** started trickling in.

In early September **Rusty Blackbirds** began appearing. Banders at VINS in Woodstock mist-netted and banded a **Connecticut Warbler** and a late **Louisiana Waterthrush**. A 4th State Record **Yellow-crowned Night-Heron**, a species not reported in Vermont since 1993, appeared in Shelburne. A **Jaeger** species was seen on 15 September in South Hero but proved too illusive for a definite identification. The next day a **Western Palm Warbler** was banded at VINS. By the end of the month Vermont had its 7th State Record for **Sabine's Gull** when two juveniles were photographed on two consecutive days in St. Albans.

October, a month with only 12 sunny days (39%), brought a trace of snow with overall precipitation 0.46 inches below average. The month saw the arrival of migrating sparrows, **Northern Shrike** and the 5th, 6th, and 7th State Records for **Black-headed Gull**. It also produced an immature **Northern Gannet** that delighted many observers on Lake Champlain from Alburg to Addison. On 11 October a 2nd State Record for a blue morph **Ross' Goose** was recorded at the Dead Creek Wildlife Management Area in Addison. This area continues as the exclusive stopover site in Vermont for Ross' Goose sightings. In Charlotte, Ted Murin sighted a **Eurasian Wigeon**, and toward the end of the month, two **Barnacle Geese** whose origin remains unknown. A hybrid goose, possibly Chinese/Greylag, was observed in Ludlow on 24 October. The end of the month brought **Barrow's Goldeneye**, **Coot** and a **Pacific Loon**. The latter, seen on Lake Champlain, was accepted as a 2nd hypothetical


State Record. The records Committee needs a second independent sighting before an observation will be accepted as a First State Record.

With only 2.4" of snow and 1.02" of rain, November's precipitation was more than two inches below normal. Virtually all of the November snows came in one storm on the 17th. The month provided only 8 sunny days (27%), a little worse than what can be expected from this the cloudiest of months in Vermont. **Golden Eagles** and **Tundra Swans** arrived early in the month. On two consecutive days illusive to rare birds were seen — on 10 November five **Gray Jays** were spotted in Ferdinand, and the next day a **Common Eider**, an 8th State Record for this species, was seen in Charlotte. On 16 November, an 8th State Record was set for **Greater White-fronted Goose** as two appeared in Ferrisburg.

The 18th consecutive banding season at VINS saw a huge increase in **Red-eyed Vireo** and **Hermit Thrush**, as well as moderate gains for **Gray Catbird** and **Common Yellowthroat**. Fall netting saw declining numbers of **juncos**, **chickadees**, **oriole** and the lowest ever for **House Finch**. One observer noted several House Finch with conjunctivitis in Weybridge. Thanks to the many hours from the VINS banders a tremendous body of knowledge is being accumulated.

While fall birding did bring its own sunshine in the form of several State Records there was no First State Record for the season. The total number of species reported was 237, including two of unknown origin and one of a Western race. One hybrid and three genera were also reported.

Thanks goes to all the compilers and observers whose efforts help to provide this data.



Ross' Goose


MANAGING EDITOR'S MESSAGE

LOONS THROUGH WATERFOWL

Three species of loon were reported during this season, including a **Pacific Loon** found by Scott Morrical in Addison. Unfortunately, Scott was the only observer of this rare western species. This was not the situation with an immature **Northern Gannet** who delighted so many birders on Lake Champlain. While **Great Egrets** were also very accommodating, providing many Vermonters their first in-state view of the species, there was only one **Snowy Egret** reported. A **Black-crowned Night-Heron** was seen in Woodstock, an unusual location for a bird usually observed west of the Green Mountains. Denis J. and Maria E. Poley located a fourth State Record **Yellow-crowned Night Heron** on the Lamotte River in Shelburne, and Herrick's Cove sheltered three **Fulvous Whistling-Ducks** whose origin remains unknown. Peter Riley and Ted Murin located a second State Record blue morph **Ross' Goose** at the DCWMA, while Ted and David Hoag found



two **Barnacle Geese** in Charlotte. The two **Greater White-fronted Geese**, an 8th State Record, discovered by Charles Gifford and Otto Meier and reported by Ted Murin, rounded out the western waterfowl visitors to Vermont. A **Eurasian Wigeon** and later a **Common Eider**, an eighth State Record for this species, were seen in Charlotte. One **Glossy Ibis** appeared out-of-season at Simm's Point in Grand Isle and remained from 29 July through 8 August.

HAWKS THROUGH WOODPECKERS

Thanks to Richard Lavallee, Ted Murin, Wayne Scott, David Hoag, Terry Hall, and Scott Morrical, fifth, sixth, and seventh State Records for **Black-headed Gull** were recorded. Liz Lackey spotted two **Golden Eagles** in Morristown. An adult **Ring-necked Pheasant** apparently reared 9 young in Cornwall. A late season **American Golden-Plover** lingered until 22 November at DCWMA and a late season **Baird's Sandpiper** was observed on 24 October. Notable too for its lateness was the report of an **Upland Sandpiper** that was *heard* in North Bridgewater. David Hoag located a **Willet** in Addison and a group of **Long-billed Dowitcher** rested at the DCWMA from 16-20 September. **Red Phalarope** were seen near Butler and Bixby Islands in Lake Champlain, and a **Jaeger** species appeared in So. Hero. Richard Lavallee, Frederick Pratt, and David Hoag added a seventh State Record for **Sabine's Gull**. Julie Nicholson's report of a **Yellow-billed Cuckoo** was the only one for the season. An unusual **hummingbird** spent time at the Wagner residence in Sheffield from August 6, 7 & 11. Despite being videotaped, the buff to light brown coloration did not offer enough information as to its species.





FLYCATCHERS THROUGH HOUSE SPARROWS

Sue Wetmore reported the only **Alder Flycatcher**. **Carolina Wren** were seen in Panton and Woodstock, and a **Blue-gray Gnatcatcher** appeared in Tunbridge. Betty Gilbert reported 38 **Eastern Bluebirds**, the largest number she had observed on one day in Dorset. Twenty-eight species of warbler were found on their migration, including a **Connecticut Warbler** that was banded at VINS on 8 September. Anecdotally, one observer expressed concern over not seeing the "usual" numbers of immature **Chestnut-sided Warblers**, while another reported fewer nests for **Black-throated Blue Warblers**. In August, a **Clay-colored Sparrow** was observed carrying food. A third State Record **Painted Bunting**, first observed by Pierre Fournier at his Hartland B&B, was corroborated and reported by Julie Nicholson and Betty Jillson. This last species rounded out the impressive list of avian leaf peepers to visit Vermont during the fall of 1998.





NOTES ON THE DOCUMENTATION OF RARE BIRD SPECIES

The Vermont Bird Records Committee (VBRC) emphasizes the importance of detailed, descriptive documentation of all rarities, rare nesting species or out-of season species. It is frustrating for both the observer and the committee to have a tantalizing sighting of a rare species rejected for listing due to insufficient details.

The committee is anxious to involve all Vermont birders in producing as accurate a Vermont state list as possible. This list and all documentation must be credible to future ornithologists who will use the material for research.

In the field, writing down the salient points of identification, talking into a tape recorder, making a sketch or taking a photograph are ways to help with accurate recounting later.

The Rare Species Documentation (RSD) form is both for filing the reports and is intended as a guide for the information needed. After completing the first page, reporters may prefer to write the description of the bird on a separate sheet of paper while also checking the form for the details requested. The committee welcomes suggestions for improving the reporting and voting process.

Again, the VBRC expresses its thanks to all observers who have contributed valuable information to the Vermont state list.
