While September 11 overshadowed the fall of 2001, bird migration continued unaffected by the sad event.

The fall of 2001 saw more of the hot, dry summer weather. Lake Champlain water levels responding to the weather produced some spectacular opportunities for shorebirding. While water levels throughout Vermont, including those in many wells and springs, dropped dramatically, the Missisquoi Bay produced a variety and number of shorebirds equaled only to those seen on the East coast. To quote Dick Lavallee, a long-time birder: "Three factors came into play in making this the most ideal fall shorebirding I've seen in 50 years. First, the lake levels were ideal. Second, September and October continued to be warm and dry, certainly encouraging birds to linger. Only three frosts (no deep freezes) were

experienced through the first week of November. This condition is possibly unprecedented."

These strange conditions may have contributed to the great number of RSD reports submitted to the Vermont Bird Records Committee for review. These reports include: **Shearwater Sp. (Manx) 1st**, S. Hero; **Black-tailed Godwit 1st**, Colchester; **numerous jaeger reports**; **Black Guillemot 5th**, G.I.; **Ringed**

Turtle Dove 1st, probable escapee, Orwell; **Henslow's Sparrow, 4th since 1979**, S. Londonderry.

There was some speculation that what appeared a high vehicular mortality rate for Barred Owl from many locations might have been due to good nesting success during the previous summer. Tony Vazzano, a birder from Sandwich, Ma. conjectured that the birds may have been moving more in search of food and that perhaps the dry weather altered their habits or the supply of their prey.

We extend our heartfelt sorrow and sympathy to all who have lost a loved one in the disaster of September 11.

LOONS THROUGH WATERFOWL

Waterfowl visiting the state this season included many reports that are being reviewed as possible State records. These reports include:

From Charlotte Town Beach a possible 8th State Record **Leach's Storm-Petrel**; an adult **Great Cormorant**, possibly a 10th State Record, was seen on Young Island, G.I.; and a **Common Eider** was observed at some distance from Charlotte, which could be a 9th Record for VT. More than 730 **American Wigeon** and 350 **Ring-necked Duck** were observed on 3-Oct at Dead Creek in Highgate. Grand Isle hosted 370 **Greater Scaup** on 3- Nov.

RAPTORS THROUGH GULLS

From Highgate Dick Lavallee: "We had tremendous high counts this year for Black-bellied Plover, Dunlin, White-rumped Sandpipers, Dowitcher (250 plus or minus in one flock), Yellowlegs (200 plus or minus in one flock), and excellent numbers of Godwits later in the season. There were also some nice high counts of non-shorebird species such as Great Egret (19 at one time), Coot, Pied-billed Grebe, American Widgeon, and Caspian Tern (7 on 29-Aug).

An 11th State record for Willet, 2 reports for Western Sandpiper (7th and 8th), a Buff-breasted Sandpiper, 2 reports for 3 individual Long-billed Dowitcher, four Wilson's Phalarope, 9th-12th and 1 adult Red Phalarope were all reported from Highgate. Another Red Phalarope, a juvenile in poor condition was reported from S. Hero and a record 10th Black-headed Gull from Grand Isle. Not to be outdone observers in Charlotte found 2 juvenile Black-legged Kittiwake and a possible 10th State Record Sabine's Gull.

Pectoral Sandpipers were widely reported and appeared in good numbers lingering well into late fall.

There was a tantalizing report for 2 Sandhill Crane from E. Barnet where one crane has summered for two seasons.

Pomarine, Parasitic, and Long-tailed Jaeger were all reported from Charlotte. All three species, Caspian, Common, and Black Tern were well represented.

From Snake Mt., 5 immature Goshawk, a Peregrine Falcon, as well as many Red-tails were banded. From the same site Golden Eagle numbers were down this year (1) compared to last (7), a fact confirmed from the Putney Mt. Hawk watch site. September 14 saw 216 Broad-winged Hawks pass over Mt. Philo in Charlotte with another 184 from the same location two days later.

DOVES THROUGH HOUSE SPARROWS

A 9th State record Boreal Owl, the second banding record for the state this year!, was netted and photographed by Rodney Olsen, who teaches Special Ed. at Middlebury Union HS and has been banding hawks and owls on the north slope of Snake Mountain for three years. This year, he started banding on September 28th. Among the owl species he has also banded this fall are 82 Northern Saw-whet, Screech, and Great Horned, as well as 1 Long-eared.

20-Aug. provided good migrating weather for Caprimulgidae when 50 Common Nighthawk were observed in Burlington.

According to Chris Rimmer: "Black-throated Blue Warbler (BTBW) is invariably the most abundant non-local bird on Mansfield (i.e. they don't breed in montane forests) in August and September. VINS studied fall migration on Mansfield in 1995-97 and found that BTBW comprised 50% of all captures of "transient" species. Of 338 BTBW we banded in those 3 autumns, only 10 (3%) were adults, and not a single bird was ever recaptured. We think these montane forests are very important as post fledging habitat for BTBW, but that conditions for feeding and pre migratory fattening may not be suitable for prolonged stays. We don't really know what BTBW do once they get up there, but they sure don't stick around."

An Orange-crowned Warbler was reported from Tunbridge. The N. Hartland Dam hosted a Connecticut Warbler and a Dickcissel, an 8th report to RVB, came from Danby.

A captured juvenile Bicknell's Thrush provided the only evidence to date (16-Aug) of successful 2001 nesting by this species on Mt. Mansfield. All 7 nests monitored by VINS failed due to predation or weather.

20-Nov. still found a lingering Hermit Thrush in Shoreham and Barn Swallows extended their nesting into early September. On 9-Nov a Snow Bunting returned to the same location it has visited for the past 3 years.
