A rainy start to the month of June soon gave way to one of the driest summers on record with temperatures fluctuating from highs in June to record lows in July. Water levels in lakes and streams dropped slowly throughout the summer. Appearing along with this uncommon weather were some rarities. Shelburne Farms had two **Glossy Ibis** and a pair of **Sandhill Crane** was found near the Barnet/Monroe Bridge, while another was seen by a hang glider at the DCWMA in Addison. A sighting for **Trumpeter Swan**, accompanied by photos, was reported from Brattleboro in early June and is being reviewed by the VT Bird Records Committee. A fifth state record for **Laugh-**



**ing Gull** came from Cabot. This bird was found in a rural pond at an elevation of 3800 feet. Another high elevation

surprise was the mist netting by researchers of a **Boreal Owl** on Stratton Mountain. A Canadian report told of the unusual occurrence of the banding of more than 100 of these owls in Tadoussac, Quebec. The high numbers from that area lends credence to belief of its being an irruptive year for this species into New England this summer. Three well-documented **Wilson's Phalarope** were spotted at DCWMA on Route 17. Meanwhile both **Parasitic** and **Pomarine Jaegers** were observed coursing along the waters of Lake Champlain. The first documented nesting in Vermont for **Red-bellied Woodpecker** was videotaped and monitored by a student, Laura New, during Spring 2001 at a nest site in Brattleboro. We assume that the family remained in the Washington Street neighborhood into the summer.

On a sad note I report the passing of Bea Guyette, a life long birder and the person who last summer located the Fork-tailed Flycatcher.

## LOONS THROUGH WATERFOWL

The recovery of the **Common Loon** continues to set records with 34 pairs producing 56 chicks, of which 47 had survived through August. Some of the factors for this success are due to the construction of artificial platforms, removal of lead sinkers and pellets from the environment, and a continued education of the general public through the usage of explanatory signs placed near pond and lake access points. The ongoing dilemma as to how to control the population of **Double-crested Cormorant** has not yet been resolved.

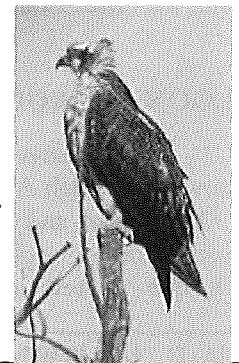

## RAPTORS THROUGH GULLS

It was another record production year for the **Osprey** with 41 of 49 nests fledging 77 chicks. The large-scale effort of providing artificial nesting sites by virtually every power company, as well as state and federal agencies and private individuals has made this possible. Not to be outdone, the **Peregrine Falcon** continues its success with a record of at least 40 fledglings from 18 sites. On the other hand **Common Tern** had a low year with the ever-present problem of Great Horned Owl predation and only a few **Black Tern** were reported from Swanton.

## DOVES THROUGH HOUSE SPARROWS

**Bicknell's Thrush** breeding success was down this year. A large crop of spruce and fir cones precipitated an invasion of red squirrels and other rodents who prey upon bird's eggs and nestlings thus adversely affecting the Bicknell's breeding success. All 5 nests monitored on Mt. Mansfield failed while Stratton Mountain had only 3 of 13 nests produced young. An interesting observation was of a Bicknell's scolding a fisher. It remains to be seen if the summer of 2002 will be more successful.

An interesting behavioral incident involved a **Common Raven** at the DCWMA area on Rte 17 who was seen carrying off a dead female Bobolink. After eating a portion the remainder was cached in a plowed section of a field. An astounding number of fifty **Brown Thrasher** was reported from Grand Isle on one day.

**Clay-colored Sparrow** has become a regular breeder in Grand Isle while the Franklin County Airport seems to be a reliable habitat for the shy **Grasshopper Sparrow**.
