
Mountain Birdwatch 2.0 Route 72: Belvidere, VT

Hike Duration/Difficulty: 2.5 hours to point 1.

Route/Trail Access: Take Long Trail north from parking area off Rte 118 West of Eden. Point 1 is approximately 250 meters north of intersection with Forest Trail up to summit. Points are all on LT. Revised 3/2016

| 1 | Facing N from pt 1. | Facing S from pt 1. | N 44.77584 W 72.55457 Elev (m) 957 | 5 meters before point, birch tree roots in trail, 5 cm diameter breast height (dbh) birch leans east. 5 m past point, 0.75m tall stump cut at an angle w/moss on cut edge. Spruce snag leans above trail 15m before (S of) point. |
| 2 | Facing E from pt 2. | Facing W from pt 2. | N 44.77740 W 72.55688 Elev (m) 939 | Point is in large clearing with almost no canopy but several bare snags. Vista to East at the point, past 2.5 meter high broken stump. Birch snag about 10 m tall, bare, white, little bark, 10 m N of point. 2.5 meter tall birch at point to E of trail. |
| 3 | Facing E from pt 3. | Facing W from pt 3. | N 44.77918 W 72.55880 Elev (m) 898 | Point 5m N of bend in trail - double white blazes on S side of tall (emergent) red spruce. Point at fallen tree across trail (9 inches dbh) that has been recently cut to leave walkway. Blow downs on W side of trail just N of point, visible from point. Dead, peeling birch snag to W of point tight between 2 balsam fir (see picture to W) |
| 4 | Facing N from pt 4. | Facing S from pt 4. | N 44.78124 W 72.56016 Elev (m) 893 | 20m south of point, forest opens up dramatically- point is in area of low/no canopy. At point to W of trail is paper birch snag around 10 m tall, cut mossy log next to it. Thin, many-limbed tree (limbs <5cm in diameter) over trail, snagged on birch. |
| 5 | Facing N from pt 5. | Facing S from pt 5. | N 44.78334 W 72.56134 Elev (m) 870 | At point, to west of trail, large (25m) many-limbed conifer snag w/rusty square metal piece nailed at eye level. Trail flat at point, begins descent 4m past point. At point, canopy 60% birch, some balsam. |
| 6 | Facing N from pt 6. | Facing S from pt 6. | N 44.78563 W 72.56099 Elev (m) 865 | Point at blow down above trail, 15 cm dbh. Just N of point, trail snakes in S shape. 12m tall birch snag 8m past point (N of point). |

Please survey this route in order, beginning with point 1. ¹Please note that waypoint locations are provided in decimal degrees.
