With support from the Director of Conservation Science, the Data Manager will collaborate with VCE partners to provide support on joint initiatives. The Data Manager is expected to work closely with VCE's data science team on the Vermont Atlas of Life and is also expected to contribute to other VCE programs including the Vermont Loon Conservation Project, Forest Bird Monitoring Program, Vernal Pool Atlas, Mountain Birdwatch, and the <a href="Mount Mountain Boundard Boundard
