The successful applicant will add data analysis and modeling capacity to several VCE projects and work closely with VCE's science team. Key qualifications include experience conducting independent research, an advanced understanding of sampling design and statistical methods, and a demonstrated publication record.

Position Summary

The Postdoctoral Researcher will support VCE's efforts to collaborate with the state of Vermont in using Vermont Atlas of Life data to evaluate the effectiveness of the Vermont Conservation Design in protecting Species of Greatest Conservation Need. By bringing analytical and modeling expertise to the team, the Postdoctoral Researcher will contribute to efforts that will better inform the development of Vermont's 2025 Wildlife Action Plan. The Postdoctoral researcher will also have opportunities to apply their skills to other VCE projects including Mountain Birdwatch, Mount Mansfield Bird Monitoring, and Vernal Pool Monitoring.

The Postdoctoral Researcher works out of our office located in the vibrant community of White River Junction, across the river from Dartmouth College. This is a full-time position with a salary of \$56,500. VCE offers health, dental, vision, and retirement benefits plus 30 days of paid time off per year. Funding is initially for one-year, but this position can be extended for an additional year based on interest and performance.
