

DIRECTIONS TO FBMP SITE AT

Pease Mt. Natural Area

Charlotte, VT

To reach Pease Mountain, a UVM Natural Area, turn east off Rt. 7 onto Church Hill Rd. Go ¹/₂ mile and turn right onto Hinesburg Rd. and continue for about ¹/₄ mile. Just past Williams Hill Drive on the right, pull into the parking lot on the right adjacent to the Charlotte Central School. The trailhead is located at the back right (SW) corner of the open field behind the school.

Point 1 – From the trailhead, follow the trail as it winds uphill and around the north slope of Pease Mt.'s eastern shoulder to the first point located along the trail.

Point 2 is about 300 m along this trail on a 4 in. dbh yellow birch.

Point 3 -- continue along the trail for 200m to Point 3 (on a 5 in. dbh hophornbeam).

Point 4 – As the trail bends due south, Point 4 is located about 50 m SW of the trail on 5 in. dbh maple.

Point 5 – Return east to the trail and follow it south for 200 m to Point 5 on a 6 in. dbh oak.

Point Count Coordinates

NOTE: Surrounding each point count station are three vegetation plots, each located 30 m away on **magnetic** bearings of 0°, 120°, and 240°. They are labeled with treetags inscribed with the point count number and a letter corresponding to the bearing: B (0°), C (120°), and D (240°). Be careful not to confuse these points with the actual point count stations.
